## Milestones:

- 1985: Dr. Gerschwin treats lycanthropy, medical records kept under wraps

- 1988: VersaLife issues scathing report of Gerschwin's research (retracted 2 wks later)
- 1989: Gerschwin Trustees suffers several unexplained deaths
- 1991: Baxter Int'l receives strange package from Gerschwin, joins Trust
- 1991: Abstergo begins receiving requests for "werewolf project," joins Trust
- 1992: VersaLife, UGH begin lycanthropy research, join Trust
- 1994: Aperture notices anomalies in portal research, joins Trust
- 1997: Zymogenetics finished development on synthesized lycanthropy virus
- 1999: Gerschwin awarded \$500M "Off the Books" grant from U.S. Military
- 2002: BioMind diagnoses lycanthropy, joins Trust
- 2004: Zymogenetics lab suffers break-in, loses \$2M in research, test animals
